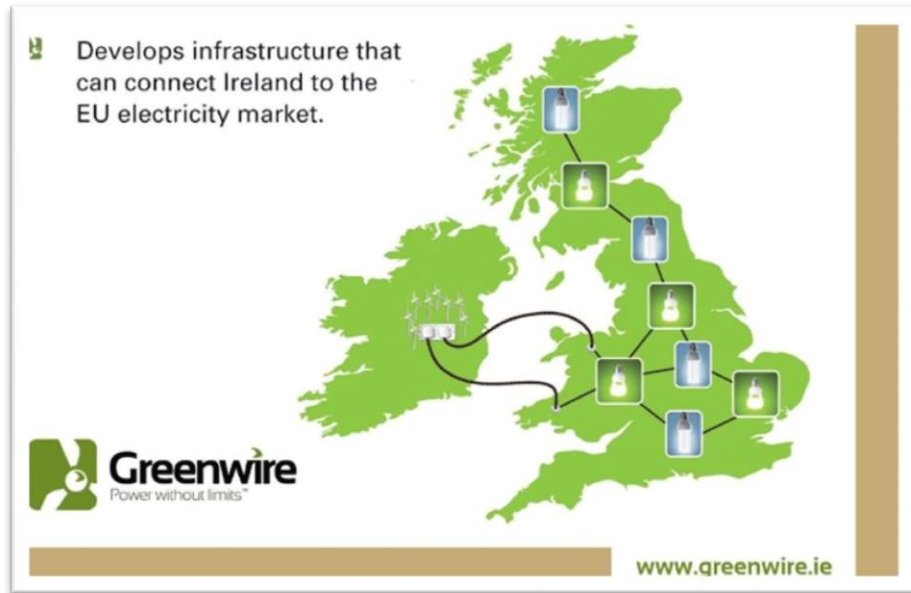


## Element Power Ireland And Greenwire Limited Are Still Pushing Massive Scale Wind Power Development.

The latest report from Eirgrid indicating large wind farm developments seeking connection to the High Voltage Transmission System indicate that Element Power Ireland and their other creature Greenwire Limited are still pushing massive scale wind power development.

Their plans include a 500MW Greenlink Interconnector linking Wexford and the UK



A 620MW MEC (Maximum Export Capacity) Windfarm scattered across MeathWestmeath, Offaly, Laois, Kildare. This would equate to 750MW of turbines amounting to about 300 of the biggest scale turbines of up to 170 metres tall.

This Windfarm is now called the Miyazaki Windfarm and it appears to be related to a 1500 MW Miyazaki Interconnector designed to link Ireland and the UK.

The latest report also details very extensive plans by Bord Na Mona.
